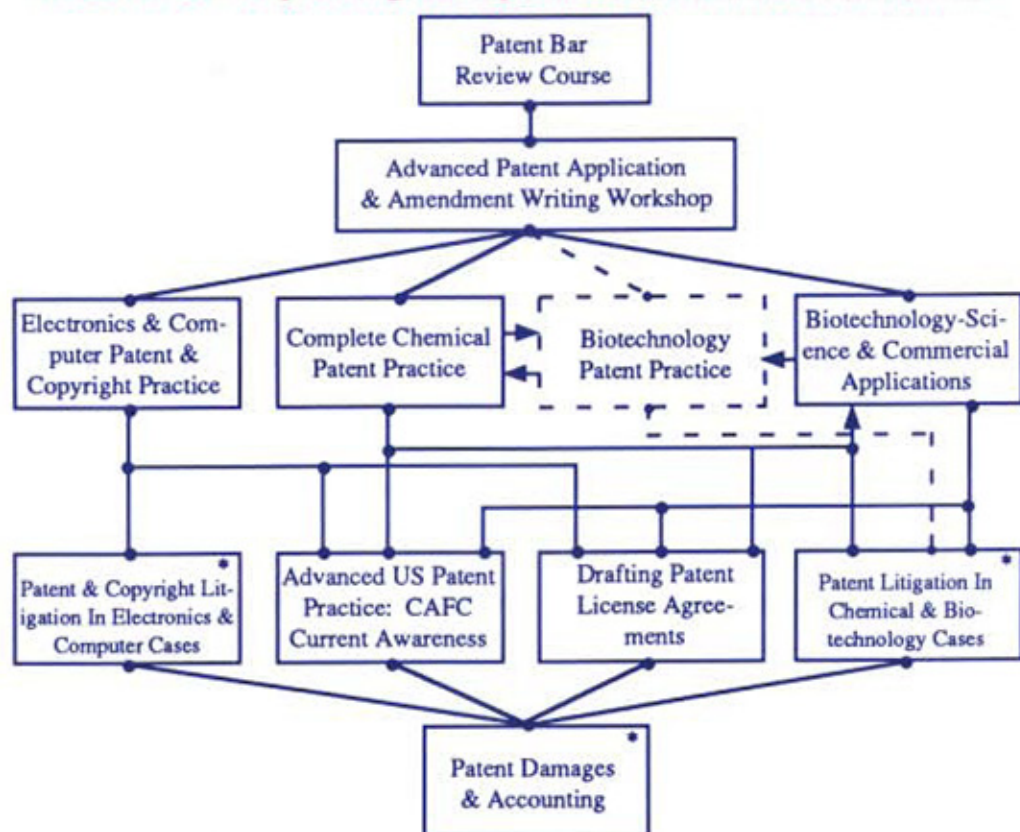
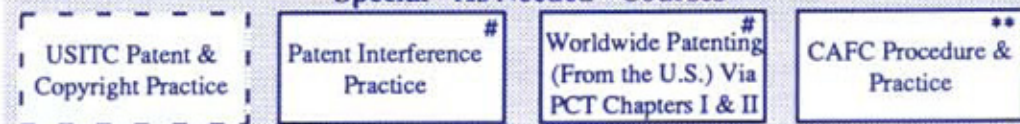


# PRG Course Sequencing For Optimum Professional Development
